We meet every Monday evening from 7.00pm to 9.00pm at Huddersfield Leisure Centre. We have a few able-bodied helpers, but if you need assistance, please ask. We welcome members of all ages.

Please note, children under 10 must be supervised at all times. Because our club has many vulnerable people we work to comply with the requirements of the Safeguarding Vulnerable Groups Act 2006.

Membership

Membership is open to anyone who is interested in supporting the aims of KDSC, whether or not they are disabled.

The annual subs are £45 for adults and £12 for under 16s. They are due from the date of the AGM, or you can pay £1 each night you come. Family membership is also available. The visitor fee is £1.

If you are not sure yet if you want to join, you are welcome to come along and just meet us or you can 'test the water' for a visitor's fee of £1 per night, provided you fill in a membership application form and a contact information sheet so the club is covered for insurance purposes.

21+ Club

Members of KDSC who are over 21 are automatically members of the 21+ Club - the social side of KDSC. Monthly trips are organised (March to November) by members to towns and cities mainly in the Metro area, where the Disabled Pass is valid. You must be able to get home from Huddersfield on your own.

Monday evening sports

On arrival at the Leisure Centre go to the café area near the entrance where you will find club members. Please give your name to the person with the register.

The activities we do are:

Occasional dry sports activities from 7.15pm until 8.30pm in the main sports hall. These include: **Football, Table Tennis and Boccia.**

Swimming is from 8.10pm until 9pm in the training pool, where we have exclusive use (you can get changed from 8pm).

Dominoes and table top games are played in the café area during the evening from 7:00pm..

Additional events and activities

As a club member you will also have the opportunity to take part in the annual Lions International Fun & Sports Day for the Disabled at Doncaster in August. We have been invited by the Holmfirth & Meltham Lions Club to attend this event since 1993.

We also have a summer outing usually to the seaside, zoo or theme park.

Awards and certificates

Presentation of swimming certificates takes place in December and at the AGM in May, when trophies are also presented.
